THE CIVIL WAR BEGAN



Fort Sumter - April, 1861
The fort covers 2.4 acres. Command from its 5 sides gave it total command of the harbor. The 4 shorter walls contained 2 tiers of arched gunrooms. The 4 shorter walls contained 2 tiers of arched gunrooms. More guns occupied the top level. The fort had 9 powder magazines, 3 on each level at both ends of the long wall. Fort Sumter was built for 120 guns and a garrison of 650 men.

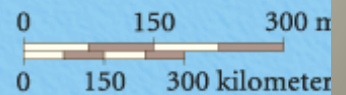
